TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

As a voice teacher, my philosophy centers around the belief that everyone has the ability to grow as a singer, be it through classical technique, musicianship, or simply training the ear to match pitch for the first time. It is my desire to meet my students where they're at and help them grow to the best of their potential through a rigorous yet positive and encouraging learning environment. I am passionate about both classical voice and musical theater styles and have studied extensively in both realms. I aim to help my students gain the building blocks of good singing technique so that they feel confident in their creative endeavors, regardless of the musical styles they choose to embrace.

ACADEMIC COURSES

- University of Memphis Intro to Voice, MUAP-1610, 6611

 Undergraduate and Graduate Intro to Applied Voice. This course is designed to be a introduction to applied voice study. The course includes discussions, practical physical instruction, technical exercises, coaching styles and diction, analyzing poetry and character, and rehearsal of musical ensemble between singer and pianist.

 An introductory course that allows students to build a foundation of singing. The purpose of the course is to gain understanding of singing and equip students to be build healthy habits. Emphasis is placed upon: various aspects of fundamental vocal technique, practice skills, developing creativities and critical thinking skills, communicating through music, and understanding healthy practice of singing.
- Samford University First-Year Vocal Intensive, MUSA 1257-1, 1257-2 Vocal training intensive that allows students to learn, practice, and become fluent in foundational singing technique and body use. Small

cohorts of first-year students spend significant time each week learning together and performing for each other. This course is intended to instill healthy fundamental vocal technique, practice skills in preparation for individual applied voice study.
