Developmental courses do not count toward total degree hours. Students having completed college level courses prior to enrollment will be assisted by their advisor in making appropriate substitutions. In most cases, general education courses may be interchanged between semesters. A minimum of 45 hours of upper-level credit (3000-4000 level) is required for this degree. Mandatory state and institutional assessment exams will be required during your degree program. Failure to participate in required assessments may delay graduation.

- 2.50 GPA in Major
- 2.50 GPA at ASU
- 2.50 GPA Overall
- Maximum of 31 credit hours via correspondence/extension/examination//PLA/Military/CLEP (30 hrs) or similar means
- 45 JR/SR Hours after completing 30 hours
- 120 Total Credit Hours
- 18 of last 24 hours must be ASU-Jonesboro courses
- Minimum of 57 hours from 4-year institutions
- 32 Resident Hours if completing second degree
