FINISH YOUR DEGREE WITH THE PACK

Our transfer program provides a seamless process for you to earn a bachelor's degree. We have **Transfer Counselors** available to assist you throughout the admissions process. Once we finish assisting you with admission to A-State, we will send you to an adviser in your respective program study, i.e. nursing, health professions or education. Ultimately, your adviser will assist you in registering for classes at A-State. Don't forget your Transfer Counselor is always a phone call, Zoom or email away.

Go to **astate.edu/apply** to fill out an application* and join the Pack! Please note the requirements for admission:

- 13 transferrable college hours with a 2.0 GPA
- Proof of 2 MMR vaccines (required for on-campus enrollment)
- Completion of English I and College Algebra or placement exam scores (English I and College Algebra are still required for the degree plan to graduate. exam scores are used for admission purposes only.)

*\$30 application fee is required. Fee is waived if students transfer from ASU System school.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I GET ADMITTED?

- 1. Setup your student email account Student Email Setup
- Apply for Financial Aid & Scholarships. Transfer students are still eligible for multiple financial aid options such as the Transfer Scholarship, Out-of-State Scholarship, Privately Funded Scholarships, etc. For more information or questions contact our Financial Aid office at finaid@astate.edu or over the phone at (870) 972-2310.
- 3. Only freshman students are required to live on-campus their first year. However, if you would like to live on-campus, please utilize the QR code on page 9 to stay updated on housing information.
- 4. Meet with an Academic Advisor. An academic advisor can help you identify courses you need to take and can help you create an educational plan. Find your advising contact by reaching out to the University Advising Center/Transfer Success Center (universityadvising@astate.edu or (870) 972-3001) and scheduling an appointment.
- 5. Register for classes.
- 6. After you have registered for your classes, learn more about campus life, student resources, campus recreation and Student Organizations that are available on campus.

TRANSFER SUCCESS CENTER

Transfer Success Center works collaboratively with the campus community to provide a quality advising experience for students and faculty at Arkansas State University. YOUR AID OPTIONS

TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is \$5,000, awarded annually, and split between the fall and spring semesters. For students in the ASU System that have received an associate degree from ASU Beebe, ASU Mountain Home, ASU Mid-South, ASU Newport, or ASU Three Rivers - an additional \$1,000 annual award brings the total to \$6,000!

- Requirements are at least 24 transferable hours and a cumulative GPA of 3.25.
- Students must be fully admitted for scholarship eligibility.
 Deadlines are July 15 for fall admission and January 8 for spring admission.

OUT-OF-STATE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship offsets out-of-state tuition costs (only pay in-state tuition and fees). The transfer requirements are a 3.25 GPA and 24 transferable hours.

Students in these following states automatically qualify for in-state tuition: Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Oklahoma, Tennessee and Texas.

A-STATE DUAL-DELIVERY HYBRID PROGRAM

This program is for students who have graduated from an accredited Arkansas two-year or four-year college and have obtained their associate degree. The program will be a mix of asynchronous and synchronous online classes. Hybrid students are eligible for the Transfer Scholarship. Finish your degree at A-State your way!




A-STATE PRIVATELY FUNDED SCHOLARSHIPS
