

Treble Clef Club of Jonesboro Music Scholarship Application

Scholarship Information

Two \$500 scholarships will be given this year to two selected music students (one instrumentalist and one vocalist) who wish to pursue or continue their education in either Music Performance and/or Music Education at Arkansas State University-Jonesboro. Note: Awards are contingent upon the quality of applicants. Thus, no award may be given, or two may be given in one area.

Eligibility Requirements

1. The student must declare Music as his/her major course of study (i.e. Bachelor of Music Education, Bachelor of Music/Performance, or Graduate music studies).
2. Deadline for the receipt of application is Friday, April 1, 2015.
3. Application **must** be accompanied by (1) an essay typewritten by the applicant explaining why he/she should receive this scholarship, and (2) a signature of endorsement from the major applied teacher (see bottom of page).
4. Applicants must audition with one selection on Sunday, April 17 in the Fine Arts Building Recital Hall, beginning at 2:00 and ending approximately 4:00 p.m. Audition times will be assigned by Wed. Apr. 13.
5. Stipulation for receiving funds mandates that the scholarship winners must perform for the May Treble Clef Club program, which will be at the Craighead County Public Library in the Round Room on Thursday, May 12, at 7:00 p.m. Each award recipient should perform for approximately 15 minutes; therefore, this involves more literature than the scholarship audition itself requires.
6. Each applicant must be currently enrolled or plan to enroll in the music program at ASU Jonesboro by August 2016 for the full Academic Year (2016-2017). Award recipients from previous years may apply.

Additional Information

1. Criteria for scholarship winners will be based on (1) audition, (2) endorsement of major applied teacher, and (3) personal essay.
2. The decision of the judges will be final. Scholarships may or may not be awarded at the judges' discretion.
3. Scholarship funds will be directly deposited to the students' A-State accounts, effective August 2016 (no checks will be awarded).
