 - a. Students receiving a bachelor's degree in those countries whose citizens are not required to take the TOEFL, namely Australia, British Isles & English speaking Canada and New Zealand
 - b. Students from the English speaking portion of the West Indies
 - c. Students from South Africa whose first language is English
