I received the following proposal from the Shared Governance Oversight Committee (SGOC) on Thursday, January 17, 2013. Pursuant to the governing language contained in the Faculty Handbook, I have reviewed the proposal carefully, consulted with other parties as appropriate, and hereby document my response:

- Proposal 12FA-003, Faculty Credentials. The SGOC met on October 22, 2012, to decide the disposition of the proposal. The SGOC determined that the proposal should receive a full review under the direction of the Faculty Handbook Committee. Set to review the proposal were the Faculty Senate, Deans Council, and Chairs Council. Following review, all three (3) constituency groups supported the proposal with comments by Faculty Senate and Deans Council.

Comments from Constituency Groups supporting the proposal:

Faculty Senate:

The Faculty Senate approved the proposal with the following comments for consideration:

Faculty Senate supports with revision of language under associate with change to baccalaureate and wording as shown on website 3. Associate Level: Faculty must have at least a baccalaureate degree or appropriate industry-related licensure or certification."

Deans Council:

The Academic Deans Council unanimously recommended approval of the ASU Jonesboro Faculty Credentials proposal (12FA-003) with a strong unanimous recommendation to significantly strengthen one section of the policy.

It is the opinion of all members of the Academic Deans Council that the stated minimum criteria for Associate Level faculty (B3), "At least one full-time faculty member must have at least an associate degree in the teaching field," is insufficient for the Jonesboro campus. Not only does the minimum criteria not apply to all faculty teaching at the associate level, the requirement of only an associate degree is not in keeping with the notion that the faculty should hold one degree higher than the level at which they are teaching, unless they hold the terminal degree.

We strongly recommend that the criteria for Associate Level faculty match that stated in the policy for Remedial Education faculty: Faculty members must hold at least a baccalaureate degree in the teaching field.
