## Arkansas State University M.S. Sport Administration Internship

The M.S. Sport Administration Online Program internship (6 credits) is offered during Summer terms only (Sum I & Sum II). The internship application is due the first Monday in February.

The internship must be completed at a sport-related organization (e.g. intercollegiate athletics, campus recreation, interscholastic athletics, professional sports, sport agencies, sport facilities, community parks & rec departments, etc.). It must be a new administrative-related experience, beyond the student's current work responsibilities. The internship site can may be at the current work place, but must have added responsibilities to current job duties. The internship requires a minimum of 300 work hours during entire summer (approximately 150 each Summer term).

Students are eligible to apply for internship if they will have completed at least FOUR MS Sport Administration courses before Summer I.
