- Whereas, athletics is one medium for creating and upholding spirit and traditions, and
- Whereas, currently, more communication between students and the athletic department is needed, and
- Whereas, there is currently no student advisory group that is designed to assess decisions and recommend ideas for future decisions of the athletic department where spirit and traditions are concerned, and
- Whereas, this advisory committee would open the lines of communication between students and the athletic department and serve as an evaluation and recommendation tool for athletics based on a student perspective.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:


1. The SGA and the student body resolve to create the Student Athletic Advisory Committee, and
2. The committee consists of fifteen student representatives that are charged with seeking out the opinions of the student body and reporting those to the committee, and
3. The students are selected by the SGA President based upon their ideas and their ability to represent the student body, and

4. The committee also consist of the SGA President and Vice President, the SAB President and Spirit Club Director, and
5. The Director of Athletics, The Assistant Director of Marketing, the Director of Marketing, and the Assistant Dean of Student Involvement serve as non-voting ex-officio members of the committee, and
6. The committee serve as an advisory group that evaluates and recommends actions of the Athletic Department concerning spirit and traditions and other issues that affect students, and
7. The committee meet bi-monthly and constantly evaluate actions and programs of the Athletic Department.
