The building's fitness facilities are very limited and

The Fitness Club, located in the Student Union, is not large enough

for ASU's student population and

Whereas,

Funds from the state do not fund Auxiliary buildings, and whereas an increase in the student union fee would fund the constructional and operational cost for a new student recreational center and

Whereas,

An increased fee would still make Arkansas State University financially competitive among competitor colleges.

## BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

- 1. In the fall of 2007, the student union fee will increase \$5 per credit hour to fund the recreational facility.
- 2. Senior students may voluntarily pay this fee in the Spring semester of 2007 in order to obtain a lifetime membership to the recreational facility.
- 3. Once the building is complete the fee will increase to \$7 per credit hour for operational purposes.
