The CoA recognizes exceptional alums who have demonstrated through their participation, commitment, and profession excellence at the highest level. These awards honor living A-State alumni who exemplify our tradition of excellence.

1. College of Agriculture, Outstanding Young Alumni Award

The award is presented to individuals (can range 1-3 per year) who bring recognition and honor back to the college through her/his profession. Honorees exemplify the important of education and demonstrates pride in the college. The recipient should be a relatively recent graduate, i.e., less than 10 years. Please consider the following when submitting nominations:

- Demonstrated outstanding loyalty, integrity and promotion of the college
- Demonstrated leadership in profession

2. College of Agriculture, Outstanding Alumnus Award

The award is presented to individuals (can range 1-2 per year) who bring recognition and honor back to the college through her/his profession. Honorees exemplify excellence in their profession and gives back (in-kind, donations, time, etc.) to the college. The recipient should have graduated more than 10 years ago. Please consider the following when submitting nominations:

- Evidence of outstanding loyalty and integrity
- Demonstrated leadership in professional and philanthropic endeavors
- Contributions to their community

3. College of Agriculture, Outstanding Service Award

Outstanding Service Award honorees exemplify excellence in their profession, community and gives back to the college. This award may include both alumni and non-alumni. Please consider the following when submitting nominations:

- Evidence of outstanding loyalty and integrity
- Significant leadership and philanthropic endeavors
- Outstanding career accomplishment in profession
- Contributions made to her/his community, state, and/or nation
- Humanitarian service, service to the University, in particular the College of Agriculture

Nomination Procedures: Please note, nominations can be self or by someone else.

Nominations should include: a) name and contact information; b) award seeking; c) a statement/narrative outlining relevant information within the award category; d) optional can be 1-3 letters of support.
