Deadlines:

- 1. A completed draft of the dissertation must be given to ALL committee members a minimum of 21 days before the **Defense date.** The completed draft must first be approved by the Research Advisor.
- 2. This form must be submitted to the EVS Program office at least 2 weeks before the scheduled defense.
- 3. A public announcement of the defense will be made by the EVS office.

The defense will consist of a written dissertation on the student's graduate research topic, publicly presented and defended, after which the student's committee will continue the defense in a private session. A Comprehensive Examination will be included as part of the private session with the committee. This exam can be oral or written in whole or in part. Possible outcomes of this examination is (i) pass, (ii) fail with option to retake (one time only) the examination, or (iii) fail.

- 4. This form should be submitted to the EVS Program Office by the end of the student's 8th semester (last semester).
- 5. **Assessment forms** (download from: http://www.astate.edu/college/sciences-and-mathematics/doctoral-programs/environmental-science/documents/) must also be given to all committee members when the dissertation is sent to the committee.
