 - a. Meeting Minutes Presented. Kelly Sabin motioned to approve the minutes. Leigh Ann Hall seconded. All unanimously approved.
 - b. Treasurer's Report presented by Pam Graham
 - c. Shared Governance Committee Updates There are no new Shared Governance updates.
- 4. Guest Speaker Dr. Russ Hannah
 - Speaking on behalf of the university's operating budget. This year, A-State was able to put the budget together without any tuition increases.
 State appropriation & revenue change \$3,914,719
 - Overall tuition increase = 0% and no fee increases and no new fees
 - Assumed Flat Enrollment Assumed that this Fall's enrollment will be equivalent to Fall 2020.
 - Salary Increases: \$2,097,883
 - Fully implemented the ADHE Classified Pay Plan, merit increases for faculty and staff, final adjustments to bring GA salaries to minimum wage, reallocated and created eight (8) new academic/recruitment positions, three (3) new faculty positions within AOS, new faculty for EMT/Paramedic, Computer Science for Data Analytics, new advisor in AOS, and two (2) new positions with Digital Creative Media.
 - Mandatory costs increases \$71,530 property & liability insurance increase, and software maintenance increase
 - How we are spending look at the finances by function, such as institutional support, student services, academic support, instruction, research, public service, plant operation and maintenance, and scholarships and awards.
 - FY22 total expenses reflects the university's priorities and difficulties.

 Strategic plan – better align our budget and resource allocations with the priorities laid out in the strategic plan. Working to be more transparent in helping the university community understand the challenges. Invite faculty and staff to participate in this Questions about budget? The BOT directed that deferred maintenance should be a focus of the university. Once the pandemic hit, the board and system office suspended that requirement. FY21 did not make those transfers. What you see in FY22 is a partial reinstatement of that.

- Windgate Foundation 3D Fine Arts Studio \$7 million gift east of the Fine Arts building. Construction was completed in May 2021 and faculty are now occupying it.
