Beck Center for Veterans Program Services:

Provides services to supplement (not duplicate) veterans' eligible government benefits and fill in the services gaps where they exist.

Education Assistance - GED, attending universities and community colleges, vocational/technical schools, financial aid programs and scholarship opportunities, career advising, career testing, disability accommodation services on campus, tutoring, mentoring resources and more.

Personal Rehabilitation Services onsite - Speech-language therapy programs, audiology, nutritional counseling, physical therapy and occupational therapy.

Mental Health Services - individual, family and group counseling services, support groups, substance abuse treatment resources and more.

Combat Veteran Support Group - provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs VET Center.
