Reading, review and approval of minutes

Minutes were approved for the Oct. 28, 2010 meeting with an edit to item #6 – Area Group Reports

Recorded was: Teacher Education/Early Childhood: (Nancy Bacot) in need of members to attend meeting.

A change in wording was approved as follows to reflect the intent of the statement: Teacher Education/Early Childhood: (Nancy Bacot) indicated all those who enrolled as members are needed for attendance and participation.

2. Course Proposals & Bulletin Changes Instructional Facilitator, ELCI 5313, ELCI 5403

A motion was made (Andy Mooneyhan) and seconded (Lance Bryant) to change the elective requirements in Middle Level Lang Arts/Social Studies for 6 hours of English and 3 hours of Social Studies <u>to</u> 3 hours of English and 6 hours of Social Studies. The motion to accept passed.

Early Childhood and Middle Level MAT Course Substitutions
